

UP Academy Boston's Operating Charter is up for Renewal

Your Help is Needed!

The purpose of this document is to provide important information regarding the future of UP Academy Boston and the renewal of the operating charter. In this document, you will find a full summary of the renewal process and implications for UP Academy Boston as well as ways you and your family can support.

Brief History of Charter schools:

- Charter schools were formed in 1993 as a result of the Commonwealth of Mass Education Reform Act and are considered independent public schools that operate under five year charters granted by the Commonwealth's Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
- Renewal is a tool that the Dept. of Elementary and Secondary Education uses to ensure Charter schools are performing well and meeting the standards outlined in the charter agreement
 - Every 5 years, charter schools have to renew the charter through an extensive process that includes creating and presenting an application, a site visit, and most importantly, testimony from parents
 - Renewal is determined by a combination of votes by first the Boston Public School Committee and then by the Board of Education through the Dept. of Elementary and Secondary Education
 - Next year (School Year 2020-21) is the final year of the current charter agreement

Implications for UAB:

- The renewal of an operating charter is not guaranteed
- Board of Education will make the final decision on whether or not the operating charter is renewed
- If the charter is not renewed, the school could be closed!

The involvement of parents and family members will be a key factor in helping the Boston Public School Committee and ultimately the Board of Education to make a decision in favor of renewing the operating charter.
